What is a Repair Cafe?

Repair cafes are pop-up events held on regular dates where the local community can get their broken household items (e.g. broken toaster, jumper full of holes, old bikes) repaired for free, or for a small donation, by volunteers.

Not only do they save items from landfill - they save people money and are great community events, bringing people together and providing the chance for the repairers to use their skills to benefit others.

As they say in their websites:

Bring along your broken or damaged item (broken toaster, coffee machine that's seen better days, jumper full of holes etc) and our volunteer repairers will try to fix it, for free. You can enjoy a cup of tea or coffee, and chat to your fellow neighbours while you wait. We'll even show you how it is done too if you like! The best way to reuse and recycle there is.

Typical repairs include: basic bicycle maintenance, electrical appliance repair, computing assistance, sewing, ornament repair, and woodworking; though we will have a look at most things, except Microwaves as they are too dangerous.
